ASTM D4977 ABRASION TESTING

Treated shingles lost only **0.13 grams** of protective granules compared to **0.39 grams** on untreated shingles during laboratory abrasion testing.

INDEPENDENT TEST RESULTS



ASTM D4977 GRANULE ADHESION

Measures the resistance of mineral granules to being removed by abrasion.

RESULT:

Approximately 67% less granule loss than untreated shingles.



67% LESS GRANULE LOSS



ASTM D3462 PLIABILITY

Measures the ability of shingles to bend without cracking at low temperatures.

RESULT:

All treated shingles successfully passed flexibility requirements with no cracking during testing.

ASTM D5 ASPHALT PENETRATION

Measures the hardness or softness of the asphalt binder.

RESULT:

Testing showed no significant adverse changes to asphalt hardness after treatment.



NO ADVERSE CHANGE



ASTM D2170 ASPHALT VISCOSITY

Measures the flow characteristics of the asphalt binder.

RESULT:

Treatment produced no significant changes to asphalt flow characteristics.

- ✓ Applied according to manufacturer instructions
- ✓ One coat at approximately 100 sq ft per gallon
- ✓ Seven-day cure prior to testing
- ✓ Test deck conditioned 16 hours at 135–140°F
