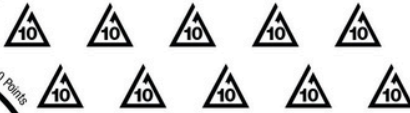

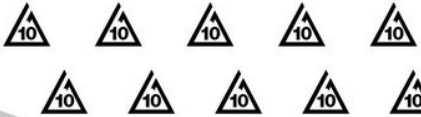

If you happen to hurt someone - on purpose or not - just say "I'm sorry," and when someone asks, "How are you?" Smile and say, "Amazing!"

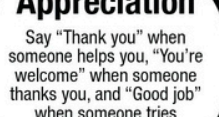
Score 'YOUR AGE x 100' Points to qualify for Gracie Game Day.

Age 10 = 1000 Points



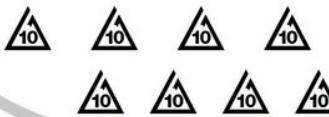
Age 9 = 900 Points
