About the airports

London City Airport

An international airport in the Royal Docks, London Borough of Newham — about 7 miles (11 km) east of the City of London and a short distance east of Canary Wharf.

London Heathrow

Originally London Airport until 1966, Heathrow is a major international airport and the second busiest in the world by international passenger traffic.

London Gatwick

A major international airport near Crawley, West Sussex, around 29.5 miles (47.5 km) south of Central London.

London Luton

An international airport 1.5 miles (2.4 km) east of Luton town centre, and about 28 miles (45 km) north of Central London.

London Stansted

An international airport in Stansted Mountfitchet, Essex, around 42 miles (68 km) northeast of Central London, serving 160+ destinations across Europe, Asia and Africa.
