



How to Identify a Male and Female Plant

Only a FEMALE Cannabis or Hemp plant produces Flowers / Buds. The MALE plants only produce Bell Shaped pollen sacs that release pollen to fertilize female plants for SEED production. MALE plants MUST be removed as soon as they are identified (destroyed / burnt) to allow the FEMALE plants to produce healthy Flowers / Buds. If you are growing for SEED PRODUCTION, then you can leave the males with the females as the female will produce SEEDS in their Flowers / Buds.

This is why companies sell FEMINIZED Cannabis and Hemp seeds. This is only a 99,9% guarantee the plants will all be FEMALE. You will still have to WALK your FIELD and look out for any MALE plants and remove them. So if you have 5860 Feminized Cannabis or Hemp plants on one hectare, there will be FIVE or SIX males between the females. Find them and remove them.

From seed to harvest is generally 140 days. You will be able to identify the males from 28 days after germination to 42 days, that is when they will start to show their sex.
