- ▶ Factory (restricted) : Factory viewing and commenting

- ▶ This is an example of an agency workspace
- ▶ Each client has their own project workspace
- ▶ Each project workspace can have multiple seasons

- ★ Tip: Images are driven through 'Manage Collection'
- ★ *Tip: you can use any type of photo png. files and are not restricted to graphics.*

WHAT YOU NEED TO DECIDE NOW

- ▶ What is the right Workplace set up for your business?
- ▶ Do you separate collections by brands? Agency model as shown earlier.
Do you segment by classification? Tees, Base Layer, Outerwear, Skirts etc.
Do you segment by Collections? Women's Running, Men's Tennis, Training etc.
Do you separate by gender? Men's, Women's, Kids?
- ★ Tip - when a group of items share a color palette it is a good indication to create a 'collection' workspace for this grouping.

 - ▶ Have a square png, or jpg image or logo ready to pull into the ‘upload file’ button
 - ▶ Click ‘Add season’
 - ▶ Enter season (SP16, FA16, March Delivery etc.)

Material Database

DO THE WORK MAKE IT REAL

Setting up your material database is the most labor intensive step in this process.

Take 30 minutes each day to enter the materials you plan to use in your new season.

No need to enter all text fields to set up a new material.

You can always edit and update throughout the season - all BOMs will be automatically updated.

- ▶ Click on the '+' sign in upper right corner
- ▶ YuGen ID = optional - use a unique identifier that's easy to remember.
- ▶ Material ID = Vendor ID (per hanger)
- ▶ Material Subtype (Fabric, Lining, Trim, Packaging etc.)
- ▶ Vendor = make sure to capture vendor
- ▶ Factory sourced. Click in case you don't have a nominated vendor and want the factory to source for you
- ▶ Artwork source and url only for items that need additional development.
- ▶ Description per hanger
- ▶ Depending on the material type you choose you'll have additional text fields you can fill in. All these are optional.
- ▶ Make sure to set the unit of measure
- ▶ Enter a price into your material
