A one-time state grant for eligible students with disabilities in grades K-12. 88 Blue Virtual Academy is a ClassWallet-approved vendor. You submit our invoice after services are completed and ClassWallet reimburses us directly — you never pay out of pocket.

TEFA · ODYSSEY PROGRAM

Texas Education for Achieving Children Act

A state-funded program for students with disabilities providing up to \$30,000 in educational support funding. 88 Blue Virtual Academy is an Odyssey-approved vendor. The state pays us directly on your behalf — you manage services through the Odyssey platform.

Art therapy & mindfulness for emotional strength and focus

Does your child struggle with anxiety, emotional outbursts, or difficulty staying focused in school? The Resilience & Regulation Series combines two of the most effective tools for building emotional strength in students with disabilities: art therapy and mindfulness practice. Through guided creative expression and evidence-based stress-relief techniques, students learn to recognize their emotions, develop healthy coping strategies, and build the self-awareness they need to navigate challenges at school and at home.

- Self-awareness and emotional identification skills

- Healthy coping tools for anxiety and overwhelm

- Improved focus and attention regulation

- Confidence through creative expression

- Strategies to apply independently between sessions

Through structured activities, peer practice, and guided discussion, students develop the communication tools and emotional intelligence they need to thrive in school, friendships, and everyday life.

- Listening, turn-taking, and expressing ideas clearly

- Empathy and perspective-taking with peers

- Conflict resolution and problem-solving skills

- Understanding of social cues and body language

Each session is tailored to your child's current emotional needs and goals. An optional 5-minute parent debrief is available following each session.

SOCIAL SKILLS INSTRUCTION GROUP

The Friend Group: Social Skills Practice Session

A structured, facilitated virtual session where students with disabilities practice real social skills alongside peers in a safe, supportive environment. Students practice starting conversations, reading social cues, handling conflict, and connecting with others. Small group sizes mean every student participates and receives feedback in real time.

Fill out the enrollment form for your selected course. You will confirm your funding source (PDSES or TEFA) and receive access to your child's virtual classroom and upcoming session schedule.

Attend & get invoiced

Your child attends all sessions via live virtual classroom. After the month's sessions are complete, an invoice is sent directly to ClassWallet or Odyssey on your behalf. No payment from you.
