Townsend Meadows is a formal 55-plus adult-lifestyle life-lease townhome community in Forest, Lambton Shores. Residents acquire a life-lease occupancy interest through Forest Non-Profit Seniors Housing Corporation rather than conventional freehold or condominium title. The current Life Lease Occupancy Agreement controls eligibility, costs, responsibilities and transfer terms.

Ownership

Life-lease occupancy interest; the sponsor owns the property.

Setting

Forest in Lambton Shores, near Lake Huron services.

The occupancy agreement controls

Do not treat Townsend Meadows as conventional freehold, condominium ownership or a rental tenancy.

What ownership means

Townsend Meadows uses a life-lease occupancy interest. Forest Non-Profit Seniors Housing Corporation owns the overall property, while the resident's agreement provides the right to occupy a particular unit and use common facilities. The exact agreement, unit description, current charges, services and duties must be confirmed for the property.

Documents and questions to confirm

- The Life Lease Occupancy Agreement, exact unit description and identity of the sponsoring corporation.
- The current agreement, community rules, fee schedule, service inclusions and reserve-fund information.
- Every current occupancy charge, what it covers, how it may change and when other charges apply.
- Interior and exterior repair, heating and cooling systems, landscaping, snow, utilities, taxes and insurance responsibilities.
- Purchaser eligibility, Board and administrative steps, disclosure materials, financing and closing conditions.
- Current access, booking rules, costs and rights attached to Meadows Hall and shared facilities.

Cost categories to separate

Purchase

Confirm price, deposit, financing, legal costs and adjustments.

Ongoing

Confirm occupancy fees, taxes, utilities, insurance and maintenance.

Future

Review fee changes, reserve planning and future obligations.

IMPORTANT

Community-level descriptions do not establish the exact access, booking rules, cost or service package for every unit. Confirm these points in the current agreement, fee schedule and community documents before relying on them.

Forest in Lambton Shores

A formal 55-plus setting shaped by townhomes, shared services, resident activities and access to Forest amenities.

A mapped community point

The mapped point identifies Townsend Meadows on Townsend Line in Forest. Use it to plan a visit, then confirm the exact unit, entrance, parking and appointment instructions before attending.

Townhome floor plans support comfortable main-floor living.

Community life

Meadows Hall supports resident-organized social and recreational activities.

Daily services

Forest provides access to shopping, healthcare, dining and daily services.

KNOW THE DISTINCTION

Townsend Meadows is currently positioned as a formal 55-plus community. Confirm the enforceable eligibility, occupancy, guest and caregiver provisions in the Life Lease Occupancy Agreement that applies to the exact unit.

Test the daily-life fit in person.

Visit the exact unit and community, assess layout, condition, parking, outdoor space and facility access, and check travel to preferred healthcare, groceries, recreation, family and services across Forest, Lambton Shores and Lambton County.

Use live discovery, then verify the property

Availability, prices, occupancy fees, services and property-specific rights can change.

Open Kevin's current search and reconcile each result with the exact address, life-lease agreement, eligibility, occupancy fees, responsibilities, rules and transfer terms.
