What the current evidence supports

Regional information describes Villages of Leacock Point as a condominium community. Obtain the current title, declaration, bylaws, rules, status certificate, fee and assessment information, service and maintenance details, home records, taxes and insurance for the exact property.

Documents and questions to confirm

- Current title, declaration, bylaws, rules, status certificate and all amendments.
- Purchase price, condominium fees, reserve fund, assessments, utilities and services.
- Insurance, maintenance boundaries, parking, storage, approvals and resale requirements.
- The purchase agreement, schedules, conditions, adjustments, inclusions and closing requirements.
- Current taxes, fees, utilities, insurance, repairs and property-specific charges.
- The home's condition, systems, additions, warranties, permits and accessibility.

Cost categories to separate

Purchase

Confirm price, deposit, financing, legal costs and adjustments.

Ongoing

Confirm condominium fees, taxes, utilities, insurance, parking and personal expenses.

Future

Review fee changes, reserve-fund work, assessments, repairs, resale and moving costs.

Important: This guide avoids fixed fee amounts. Obtain current home-specific legal and financial records and professional advice before relying on any estimate.

The mapped community point is in Orillia. Use the map to plan a visit, then confirm the exact home, entrance, parking and appointment instructions.

Confirm access to the community centre, exercise room, hair salon and dining options.

Home-specific fit

Inspect layout, condition, accessibility, parking, storage and outdoor areas.

Orillia access

Test routes to healthcare, groceries, downtown, beaches, trails and family.

Explore the amenities, waterfront and downtown Orillia.

Regional information highlights community amenities, beaches, a museum, walking trails and proximity to downtown Orillia. Confirm current access, services, charges, hours and guest rules.

Use live discovery, then verify

Search results, prices, charges and property-specific responsibilities can change.
