Questions for Personal Reflection and Group Discussion

1. Read Luke 15:1-10.

What kinds of people came to hear Jesus teach? Why would the Pharisees and teachers of religious law be upset about that?

To whom is Jesus telling the stories of the lost sheep and coin? What do you think Jesus is wanting them to understand about God?

2. Read Philippians 1:6 and 3:12.

What does Paul say about God's activity in the lives of believers? Where do you see the activity of God in your own life right now?

3. Read Romans 5:8.

What do you learn about God's grace in this verse? How have you experienced His seeking of you in your life?

4. Read John 1:14.

What did Jesus do to help humanity better understand God and His grace? How does the fact that Jesus experienced all of what it means to be human encourage you?

5. Read 2 Peter 3:9.

What does this verse tell you about God's heart toward humanity? What does this demonstrate about His grace?

6. Read 2 Corinthians 3:18.

The first part of this verse talks about your role in showing grace to others. What are believers to do?

What is the job of the Spirit?

In what ways has it been a challenge for you to accept your role and not try to take on the role of the Holy Spirit?

7. Read Romans 8:1 and John 16:8.

What is condemnation? Who has been freed from condemnation? What is conviction and Who is responsible for it?

8. Read 1 John 3:18 and Hebrews 10:24-25.

What part does grace call you to play in the lives of those around you who are in the process of becoming more like Jesus? How will you extend grace to those around you this week?
