**Questions for Personal Reflection and Group Discussion**

**1. Read Matthew 16:13-16.**

Where might the 'people' Jesus referred to in verse 13 have received information about Jesus? Where did the disciples get their information?

Where do people in our world today find information about Jesus? What influences shape their perspectives?

What influences and experiences have shaped your understanding of who Jesus is?

**2. Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-9.**

What verification of authenticity does Paul provide for his message about Jesus? What transformations occurred that validated the truth and power of the gospel?

In what ways has your life been transformed by the death and resurrection of Jesus? Are you motivated to share the transforming power of the gospel as experienced in your own life with others? Why or why not?

**3. Read Acts 4:20.**

What risks did Peter, John, Paul and the other apostles take in sharing the story of Jesus? Why were those risks worth taking?

What risks do you face in sharing with others about Jesus? Are they worth taking or do they stop you from sharing?

**4. Read John 1:29.**

What did Jesus, the Lamb of God, accomplish on the cross? Who was it for?

What does His death and resurrection mean to you?

How are you living on a daily basis in light of what Jesus has done for you? Is He calling you to a next step of surrender or obedience? What is it and when will you take it?
