Questions for Personal Reflection and Group Discussion

1. Read 2 Timothy 1:1-2.

Who wrote this letter and to whom was it written? How does the author describe the relationship between them?

What does the writer say about his identity and calling? Why was this information important?

What did Paul want God to grant to Timothy? Why would those specific things be of such great importance?

2. Read 2 Timothy 1:3-7.

What words or phrases of encouragement from Paul to Timothy do you find in these verses? What is Paul urging Timothy to do and who is he challenging Timothy to become?

Think about your spiritual family members – what words of affirmation, encouragement or motivation could you share with them this week?

What do you think Paul meant when he encouraged Timothy to fan into flames the spiritual gift God gave him?

What spiritual gift(s) has God given you? Are you using them or letting them sit idle? What might it look like for you to ‘fan into flame’ the gift(s) God has given to you?

3. Read 2 Timothy 1:8-12.

Are there certain people, places or circumstances in your life where you are reluctant (ashamed?) to speak about Jesus? What role does fear play in your choice to be quiet rather than to speak up?

What does Paul say God did for us and why did He do it? How is this Good News for you?

4. Read 2 Timothy 1:13-14.

The word ‘guard’ carries the idea of protection. What are we called to protect, what does it mean to protect it and how do we do that?

5. Read 2 Timothy 1:15-18.

When things get tough, some bail out and others lean in. When following Jesus is hard, what’s your tendency? Where is God calling you to take a step of obedience this week?
