**Questions for Personal Reflection and Group Discussion**

**1. Read Isaiah 6:1-5.**

What does it mean that God is holy? Why is it so important that we understand this attribute of who He is?

How did Isaiah respond to what he saw in his vision of God's throne room and what did being in the presence of Jesus help Isaiah to understand about himself?

Why is awareness of God's holiness so important? How does it impact your perspective of Him and of yourself?

**2. Read Jeremiah 17:9.**

How has your understanding of the holiness of God helped you to see the wickedness of your own heart?

*"An idol is anything you trust, love, fear, or obey more than God."*

Consider your own heart. What do you trust, love, fear, or obey more than God in your everyday, ordinary life? What has your attention or affection more than He does?

**3. Read Colossians 3:5.**

What idols are underneath the sins Paul lists in this verse? What do the idols offer that makes them so appealing? Which idol has the strongest pull on your heart?

**4. Read Romans 1:21-25.**

In what area of your life have you traded the truth of God for a lie and found yourself serving an idol rather than trusting God?

Serving an idol will always come with a price. What has it cost you? How is what you are worshipping in place of God shaping who you are becoming?

**5. Read Exodus 20:3-5.**

What does God mean when He says He is 'jealous'? Why does He describe Himself that way?

**6. Read Isaiah 6:6-8.**

How did Isaiah's understanding of his heart impact his response to God's question? How does knowing you are fully seen, fully forgiven, affect your response to God? Where might He want to send you?
