Questions for Personal Reflection and Group Discussion

1. Read 2 Kings 6:8-10.

What do you learn about the king of Aram in verse 8? What is he doing and with whom is he consulting about his plans?

What do you learn about Elisha in verses 9-12? How is he described?

What do those descriptive words about Elisha tell you about whom he is listening to and talking with about the aggression of the king of Aram?

What action does Elisha take and what happens as a result?

2. Read 2 Kings 6:11-13.

How does the king of Aram respond to the information given to him by his officers? What is his plan of action?

In whom or what does the king of Aram put his confidence? What makes him think he has the upper hand in this situation with Elisha?

From a human perspective, whom do the odds favor between the king and Elisha? Why?

3. Read 2 Kings 6:14-16.

What did Elisha's servant see when he went outside in the morning and how did Elisha respond to his servant's morning report?

What reality existed that the servant's physical eyesight couldn't perceive?

In what ways can you identify with the servant's limited vision and his response to what he saw as a threat?

4. Read Ephesians 6:12.

What does this verse tell you about the world that you live in?

Is your daily perspective limited to what you can physically see? How aware are you of things going on around you that you can't see? What might happen if you asked God to open your eyes?
