

Days 1 – 3

Day 4

Toward the Maremma: Siena & Montalcino

Depart Florence by private transfer as the landscape shifts from Renaissance rooftops to rolling golden valleys. Two exceptional stops mark this transitional day southward.



Siena Cathedral — Skip the Line

Step inside one of Italy's most breathtaking Gothic cathedrals. Marble inlaid floors, soaring striped columns, and centuries of devotion make this a moment of genuine awe. Your private guide brings its stories to life.



Casato Prime Donne, Montalcino

Lunch and a Brunello wine tasting at this celebrated all-female estate — a winery known not only for its elegant wines but for its pioneering commitment to women in Italian viticulture. An unforgettable pairing of flavor and inspiration.

Arrive in **Follonica** at the **Hotel Riva Toscana Resort** in the late afternoon, with the evening free to unwind by the Tyrrhenian coast.

Day 5

Hilltop Villages & the Art of Tuscan Cooking

Travel inland to the dramatic tufa stone villages of **Pitigliano** and **Sorano** — ancient settlements carved directly into volcanic rock, suspended above deep ravines and centuries of history. The morning belongs to the kitchen: a hands-on cooking class led by local experts introduces you to the bold, earthy flavors of southern Tuscany's culinary heritage.

In the Kitchen

Learn traditional recipes rooted in the *cucina povera* tradition — simple, seasonal ingredients transformed into deeply satisfying food. Work alongside local cooks, share stories, and sit down together to enjoy what you've made.

On Foot

Afternoons in Pitigliano and Sorano are yours to wander freely — narrow alleyways, volcanic rock archways, sweeping viewpoints, and small artisan shops offering handmade ceramics and local specialties.

Day 6

Thermal Wellness & a Farewell Under Tuscan Stars

Morning: Terme di Sassetta

Begin the day at the **Terme di Sassetta**, a serene thermal spa nestled in the Tuscan hills. Warm mineral waters, surrounding woodland, and the quiet pleasure of doing nothing at all — this is restoration in its purest form. Let the landscape hold you.

Afternoon: Castagneto Carducci

A gentle stop in this hilltop village overlooking the Etruscan Coast — perfect for slow walks, photographs, and lingering over a coffee with a view that seems to go on forever.

Evening: Farewell Dinner

Gather for a memorable farewell dinner in a setting chosen for beauty and ambiance — **Bolgheri, Populonia, or Baratti** — selected seasonally to offer the finest experience. A fitting toast to seven extraordinary days.





Day 7

Return to Florence & Fond Farewell

After a final breakfast at the Hotel Riva Toscana Resort, your private transfer brings you back to Florence, completing the arc of the journey. Your tour leader accompanies you to the last, ensuring a smooth and unhurried departure. As a final gesture, each traveler receives a **farewell gift** — a small, curated keepsake to carry the memory of Tuscany home. End of services.
