Join us as we publicly witness to our faith and walk with Our Lord Jesus Christ in the Most Holy Eucharist.

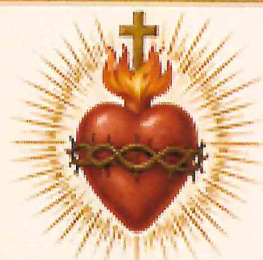
As our nation is consecrated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, we gather as a parish family to honor Christ truly present among us and to proclaim His love to our community.
