Cooling Period

As temperatures continue to drop throughout the coming weeks, so will your "numbers"! Whether those numbers will include your scores or not is entirely up to how you plan to approach the cooler weather.

Cooler weather reduces flexibility ratios, ball compression, and overall carry distances. As such, it is important to compensate accordingly.

Fall golf calls for a great deal of diligence throughout your round. Distance loss will be most noticeable in the early morning and evening hours, and far less impactful during the warmest parts of the day.

Plan to club up during cooler periods of your round, but be prepared to adjust as temperatures rise.
