1. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Mason Brooks (#7) profiles as an elite, high-impact two-way prospect whose game is anchored by premier bat-to-ball barrel accuracy, supreme on-base discipline, and plus arm velocity on the mound. Brooks combines top-of-the-order run creation with middle-of-the-order extra-base run production, while serving as a frontline power arm capable of shutting down nationally-ranked competition.

3. TARGETED OPPORTUNITIES FOR PLAYER GROWTH & DEVELOPMENT

1. Power Profile: Converting Gap-to-Gap Doubles into Over-the-Fence Home Runs

The Current Dynamic: Mason generates elite extra-base slugging (.830 SLG, 1.510 OPS) fueled by 14 extra-base hits (12 doubles, 2 triples), but currently has **0 home runs over the fence**. His swing produces a level, flat plane through the hitting zone with heavy backspin carry.

- Attack Angle & Point of Contact:** Transition his flatter swing plane to a slight upward attack angle (+4° to +6° on pitches in the middle-to-upper third). Catching the ball 2–3 inches further out in front on pull-side fastballs will instantly translate his 60+ mph exit velo into over-the-fence home runs.
- Rotational Force & Kinetic Transfer:** Introduce medicine ball rotational throws and lead-leg block drills to maximize ground-force energy transfer from his lower half into his hands, boosting exit velocity by 3–5 mph.
- Two-Strike Adjustability:** Maintain his flat, defensive two-strike contact stroke while hunting early-count elevated fastballs with aggressive upward intent.

2. Pitching Command: Maximizing 64 mph Arm Talent into Shutdown Efficiency

The Current Dynamic: While Mason's 64 mph fastball blows by opposing hitters, his run prevention metrics (6.10 ERA, 2.10 WHIP) trail his pure stuff due to arm-side misses into right-handed batters and extended pitch counts.

- First-Pitch Strike Attack:** At 64 mph, hitters rarely square him up early. Attacking the heart of the zone on 0-0 counts will force weak early contact and cut down deep counts.
- Landing Foot Alignment & Direction:** Ensure his stride foot lands consistently on-line toward home plate to avoid falling off toward first base, which causes his fastball to sail inside to righties.
- Secondary Off-Speed Weapon:** Develop a dependable circle changeup (-8 to -10 mph off his fastball) to keep advanced hitters off balance when they sit dead-red on 64 mph heat.

- **Proven Success Playing Up:** Competed up against older age brackets, highlighted by a **complete-game pitching performance allowing only 2 Earned Runs against a top-ranked team at the higher age division.**
- **Multi-Roster Guest Playing Versatility:** While guest playing across organizations is occasionally scrutinized by traditional programs, in advanced player development it represents an elite accelerator: a demonstrated commitment to *making oneself uncomfortable in new, high-stakes environments*. Navigating unfamiliar dugout dynamics, adapting to different coaching strategies, and executing with unfamiliar catchers builds rare mental poise and high-level baseball IQ.

Overall Prospect Grade: 9.6 / 10 (Tier 1 Regional Anchor / National Prospect)

Mason Brooks pairs an elite contact and on-base profile with top-tier arm strength and exceptional competitive character. Having thrived against older, nationally-ranked competition and proved his adaptability across multiple team environments, Mason has the ceiling of a premier high-impact two-way player as he continues to add elevation to his power stroke.
