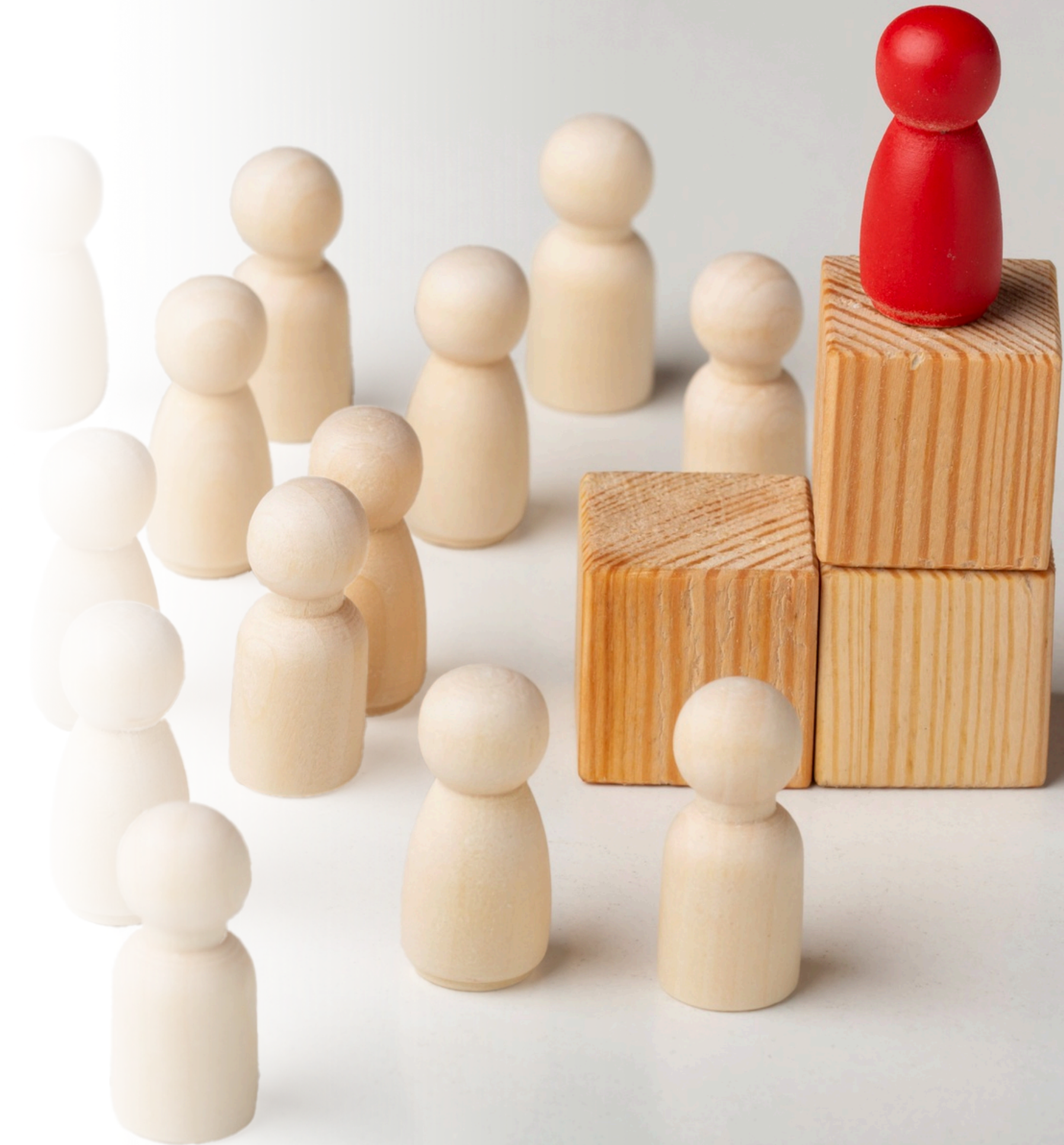
STUDENT LEADERSHIP

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The Student Representative Council (SRC) and Sekretariat Rakan Muda (SRM) provide structured platforms for students to step into leadership roles, represent their peers, and take ownership of key student initiatives. Through these roles, students develop leadership capability, communication skills, decision-making, and accountability while working closely with management and organising campus-wide activities.

Students gain direct experience in planning, coordination, and execution, managing responsibilities, leading teams, and handling real situations that require initiative and judgement. This exposure builds confidence, strengthens discipline, and prepares students to take on leadership roles beyond campus with clarity and responsibility.



THE STUDENT REPRESENTATIVE COUNCIL (SRC)

The Student Representative Council (SRC) is the official student leadership body, entrusted to represent the voice of the student community and to lead initiatives that shape campus life. SRC members act as the bridge between students and management, bringing forward ideas, feedback, and concerns while contributing to decisions that enhance the overall student experience.

Serving in the SRC provides direct exposure to real leadership work. Students take the lead in planning and executing events, managing student engagement activities, and coordinating across departments to deliver outcomes.
