Each activity places students in real environments where they support, organise, and deliver. This builds responsibility, strengthens character, and develops the confidence to contribute effectively to society while gaining practical, real-world experience.



# ACTIVITY HIGHLIGHT: **RURAL COMMUNITY SUPPORT INITIATIVE**

Students organised outreach activities in underserved areas, delivering essential supplies and engaging with local families. They coordinated logistics, managed distribution, and interacted directly with the community to ensure needs were met and delivered.

## Impact:

120 beneficiaries reached

45 student volunteers

300 items distributed



# ACTIVITY HIGHLIGHT: **YOUTH MOTIVATION AND LEARNING CAMP**

Students organised and facilitated interactive sessions for school students, focusing on motivation, teamwork, and goal setting. Activities included group challenges, high-energy team games, leadership drills, scenario-based activities, collaborative tasks, peer sharing, and guided reflections.

## Impact:

90 students participated

35 MCS volunteers

2-day programme delivered



# ACTIVITY HIGHLIGHT: **ENVIRONMENTAL CLEAN-UP CAMPAIGN**

Students carried out a coordinated clean-up effort in public spaces, managing waste collection and promoting environmental awareness among the community.

Impact:

150 kg waste collected

70 student volunteers

1 public site restored
