Exciting news for the community pool this year! We will be implementing an electronic sign in system for owners and guests. This will allow us to better track activity and provide rental homeowners more data on usage. Please note that the board has taken into consideration the pool rates for rental homes, and the new rates will be based on number of bedrooms the property has. 1-2 bedrooms will be \$150 for the season and 3+ bedrooms will be \$300 for the pool amenity fee. More details will be included in your 2026/2027 dues statement.
