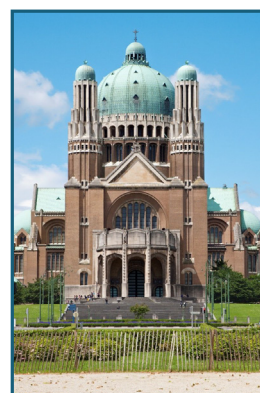
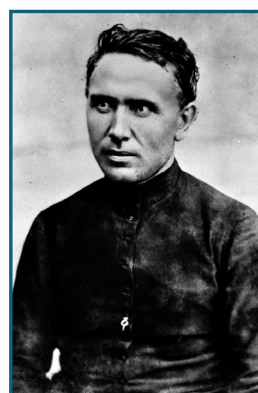
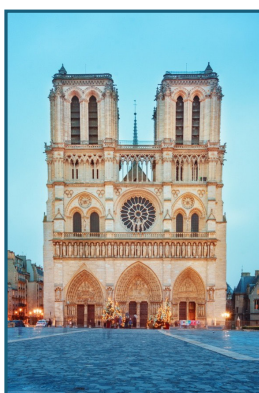

PILGRIMAGE HIGHLIGHTS:

France

Tours – Basilica of St. Martin of Tours, patron saint of the poor

Poitiers – Sites related to the founding of the Sacred Hearts Congregation

Paray-le-Monial – Place of the mystical visions of the Sacred Heart by St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, including the Apparitions Chapel, Basilica of the Sacred Heart, and Chapel of St. Claude Colombiere.

Nevers – St. Gildard Convent and incorrupt body of St. Bernadette of Lourdes

Lisieux – Basilica of St. Therese, the Little Flower of Jesus

Paris –

- **Chapelle Notre-Dame-de-la-Paix de Picpus** and Picpus cemetery, housing the graves of Pierre Coudrin — co-founder and first leader who guided the early Congregation, and Henriette Aymer de La Chevalerie.

- **Montmartre** – Basilica of the Sacred Heart
- **Notre Dame Cathedral** – recently restored to all of its splendor
- **Chapel of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal** - St. Catherine Labouré is entombed here
- **Church of St.-Vincent-de-Paul** – housing St. Vincent's relics

Belgium

- **Tremelo** – Birthplace of St. Damien of Molokai
- **Louven** – St. Anthony's Chapel and the tomb of St. Damien
- **Brussels** - Basilica of the Sacred Heart in Brussels, where Fr. Damien was beatified by Pope John Paul II on June 4, 1995
