

Privacy Policy

A complete standalone privacy policy for Reset Report subscriptions, editorial contact points, downloads and related communications.

1. Controller at each collection point

Each Reset Report subscription, download, inquiry, meeting-request or contact form identifies the controller for that collection point. A PFC-controlled form identifies Adrian C. Spitters and aspitters@pfcwealthsolutions.com. A Merrick Wealth-controlled form identifies Peter J. Merrick and peter@PeterMerrick.com. The Reset Report brand itself is not automatically the controller and does not merge the privacy responsibilities of either business.

2. Information collected and purposes

The named controller may collect contact information, consent and unsubscribe records, communications, requested editorial materials, form submissions and limited website, device, cookie, analytics and security information. Information is used to provide requested editorial material, administer subscriptions and communication preferences, respond to inquiries, protect systems and meet legal obligations. It is not used to create a regulated client relationship through a Reset Report form.

3. Consent, sensitive information and sharing

The named controller seeks consent where required and provides an unsubscribe process for commercial electronic messages. Do not submit account, medical, detailed financial, insurance or identification information through a general Reset Report form. Information is not automatically shared among PFC, Merrick Wealth, MAX Financial Ltd., Axxess Capital Advisors Inc., New World Precious Metals or another organization. A referral or service request must identify the responsible organization, its privacy notice and required consent.

4. Providers, cross-border processing and cookies

The named controller may use website, hosting, form, email, scheduling, analytics, security, record and backup providers. Information may be processed outside a province or outside Canada and may be accessible under applicable local laws. Sites may use essential, preference, analytics, embedded-content and security technologies; a required consent mechanism applies to non-essential technologies.

5. Safeguards, retention and incidents

Each controller applies safeguards appropriate to the sensitivity and volume of the information it controls, including access controls, secure systems, confidentiality obligations, service-provider oversight, backups and incident-response practices. It retains information only as long as reasonably necessary for the stated purpose and legal obligations, then securely deletes, destroys or anonymizes it. Suspected incidents are assessed and reported or notified where applicable law requires.

6. Access, correction and complaints
