The working instruments. Everything a parent can run themselves.

P	Check These First 9 conditions · 5 min · parent	Runs for every family, before anything else. Also as a one-page circle-the-answer sheet.
P	The Quick Checks 7 checks · 1–3 min each · parent	Question level, naming fluency, definitions, three-step, accuracy and speed, the closing question, reading comfort.
P	The Home Reading Check 10 min · parent · print required	Three levels, matched passages. Tells you whether the difficulty is the words or the meaning. The routing
W	Eye tracking and fixation online · anyone	eyetrackingfixation.netlify.app
W	Rapid pattern recognition online · anyone	rapid-pattern-recognition.netlify.app
P	Three Sheets training · parent-delivered	Attention Arrows, Fixation, Stroop. Graded levels, no cost.

NEEDS A TRAINED PERSON

Full administration scripts included. Currently run by you, in person or by screen share.

T	Ten-Minute Screen 10 min · trained	Rapid naming, digit span, sentence repetition, phoneme elision, cancellation. Recording sheet included.
T	Paired Passage Probe 20 min · trained	Ten original passages, four contrasts, planted contradiction. The clinical version of the Home Reading Check.

PARENT DECKS

One topic each, 10–12 slides, speaker notes written as narration.

D	School Meeting 9 slides	The equation, the engine, where it breaks, and two ways to start.
D	Admin First Meeting 9 slides	Their two numbers, the growth arithmetic, and the smallest possible ask.
