Leaf Scramble

Objective

This is a fun Fall game!
The goal of this game is to collect as many leaves (i.e. bean bags) as possible.

Set-Up

- Divide participants into 4 groups.
- Use cones to mark off a large square area.
- Place a coloured bin or hula hoop at each of the four corners.
- Assign each group a corner.
- Have participants scatter "leaves" (i.e. bean bags) around the activity space.
- On your "GO!" signal, participants run around collecting "leaves" and placing them into bins in their corner.
- Only one leaf/bean bag can be picked up at a time.
- Continue the game for 2-3 minutes.
- Each group then counts how many "leaves" they've collected.
- Change groups and play again.

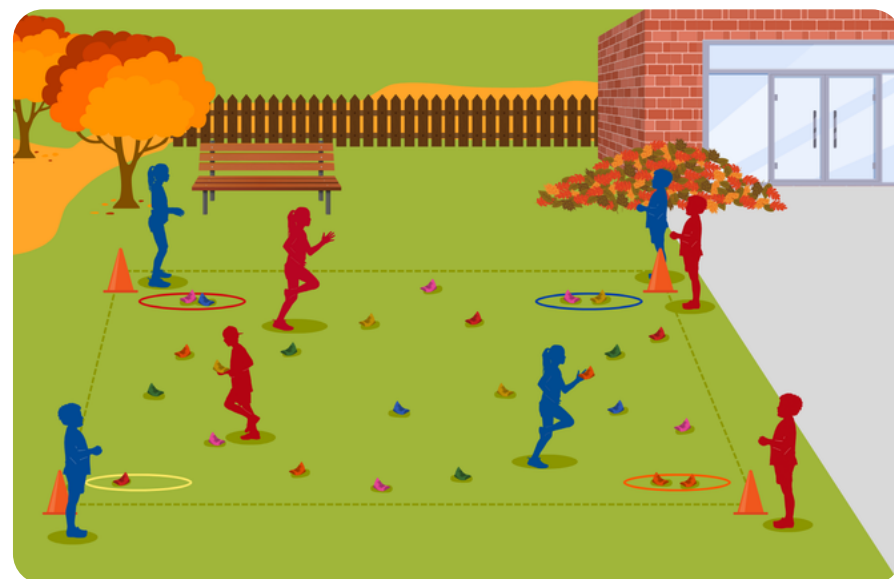
Adaptations and Modifications

- Decrease or increase the size of the activity space.
- Change the way participants move (e.g. big steps, galloping, skipping etc.) to collect the leaves.
- Groups are assigned colours (i.e. red group can only collect red bean bags).
- If possible, have participants collect real leaves.

Safety

- Ensure that activity space is clear of tripping hazards.
- Remind participants to keep their heads up.
