- Singing strengthens auditory discrimination, phonological awareness and vocabulary development
- Rhythm and movement support attention, memory and self-regulation
- Shared music experiences build communication and social connection

These experiences support the development of foundational language and cognitive skills and contribute to reducing developmental vulnerability in the early years.
