RE: Required Immunizations for the 2025-2026 School Year

Dear Superintendents, Administrators, and School Health Staff:

Immunizations are an important way to ensure the health of your students, their families, and your community. As we approach the 2025-2026 school year, please remember only students who meet the Texas minimum vaccine requirements are allowed to attend school, either virtually or in-person.

Immunization requirements for the coming 2025-2026 school year stay unchanged. You can find detailed information on the complete state vaccination requirements in the Texas Administrative Code, [25 Texas Administrative Code, §97.63](#).
