June 6 - 23 (M-Th; 8:30 am – 11:30 am)

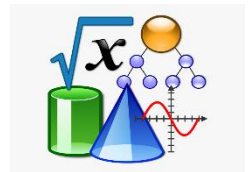
Scholars who did not pass the Spring 2021 STAAR assessment are required to complete 30 hours of accelerated instruction.
