EB/EL Incoming Kinder – 1st Program

Audience: Emergent Bilinguals Incoming Kinder - 1st Grade

June 5-28 (Mon-Thu; 7:45am – 4:15pm)

Emergent Bilinguals incoming to Kinder and 1st grade will receive special instruction focused on language development and essential knowledge and skills appropriate to their level. It also addresses their affective, linguistic, and cognitive needs.

EB/EL Summer Enrichment Camp

Audience: Current GT Students Kinder-12th

High School EOC Retest

Audience: Students in 9th -12th by Invitation Only

June 5-15 (Mon-Thu; 8:30am – 12:30pm)

Students who did not achieve an "Approaches Grade Level" score in the EOC Biology, Algebra I, English I, English II, and US History tests, will receive additional, targeted support in their individual subjects prior to the Summer EOC Retest.

High School Credit Recovery

Audience: Students in 9th -12th by Invitation Only

June 5-15 (Mon-Thu; 8:30am – 12:30pm)

A student who previously has taken a course or subject (but did not receive credit) may be permitted to earn credit.

High School Attendance for Credit Program

Audience: Students in 9th -12th by Invitation Only

June 5-15 (Mon-Thu; 8:30am – 3:00pm)

This program is to ensure that all students are in attendance 90% of the time a class is offered to certify successful accrual of credit or final grade. Students with excessive absences have the opportunity to regain credit or final grade for their classes.
